

# **Application Instructions**

## **The Humboldt Veterinary Technician Association Professional Advancement Scholarship**

**Philosophy:** The Humboldt Veterinary Technician Association is a non-profit organization comprised of veterinary technicians, animal health professionals, and support staff. We believe that the field of veterinary medicine and animal health is unique, requiring special talents and qualifications. This educational scholarship is designed to facilitate participation in veterinary medicine and its affiliated fields, which will also improve the quality of animal health care delivered to patients in our communities.

**Source of Funding:** Funds have been set aside by the Humboldt Veterinary Technician Association to support educational programs. Contributions made to our organization will directly benefit scholarship applicants.

**Description:** Each year the Humboldt Veterinary Association will select a scholarship recipient who is dedicated to furthering their education in any animal health related fields.

**Criteria/Eligibility:** Applicant must be a Humboldt County resident who is gainfully employed in a veterinary hospital, animal shelter, or Sequoia Park Zoo. Applicant will be asked to provide proof of registration or enrollment or attendance.

**Applications/Awards:** One \$250 scholarship will be awarded **in the form of reimbursement** after proof of registration or attendance has been received and verified. In order to be considered, application packets must be received annually by July 15th, 2019. Recipient will be notified by August 1st .

**If the recipient does not use the award for its intended purpose, the award amount will be forfeited, or if the award is not used within one year's time the remainder of the award will be forfeited and returned to the scholarship fund of the Humboldt Veterinary Technician Association**
